INTRODUCTION

Naway Wraz is a UN Joint Programme for Merged Districts that aims to provide support to the citizens of ex-FATA by ensuring and assisting the smooth return of the people that were temporarily displaced by the military operation in the area. The programme is working in close collaboration with the Government of KP, providing basic services and livelihood to the returnees and supporting the administrative merger of FATA with the KP province. In the wake of the 25th Constitutional Amendment of 2018, the programme focuses on 5 Merged Districts (MDs) of KP.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL MECHANISM (GRM)

Safeguarding and prevention of sexual exploitation is a top priority for the UN. Naway Wraz programme has developed a strong Grievance Redressal Mechanism (GRM) to receive direct feedback from the communities and stakeholders on the delivery of the programme. The communities benefiting from the programme are requested to provide regular feedback through these channels for continuous improvements.

In Q6, the RCO-led GRM mechanism received **13** complaints and **2** feedbacks. The complaints raised concerns around targeting, delays in service provision, fraud and coordination. **11** complaints have been addressed and **2** are under-process while **2** feedbacks received are on appreciation of timely support by the delivery partners and improving service quality.
